


Albatross glider

You will need

- Thin white card (check the recycling!)
- Cutting board
- Craft knife
- Scissors
- Colouring pens or pencils
- Glue or Pritt stick
- Paper clip

Want you do ...

- Trace the three glider templates shown here on to thin card and cut them out
- Lay the pieces on a cutting board and use a craft knife to cut the slits marked on the body shape - you may need an adult to help with this
- Colour the the albatross's beak, eye and feathers, as shown
- Push the wings and tail through the slots in the body that were cut
- Bend down the wing flaps
- Slip a paper dip over the nose of the glider to add weight
- Watch the albatross fly through the air
