





Animal plate masks

You will need ...

- Paper plates
- Coloured card (for example black, brown, pink, white and grey)
- Elastic thread
- Felt-tipped pens
- Pencils
- Scissors
- Glue of Pritt stick

What you do ...

- Decide what kind of animal your mask is going to show. Draw the animal face in pencil on the back of the paper plate.
- Mark eyeholes in appropriate places and cut them out.
- Make small holes on each side of the mask; then thread the elastic through and lie knots on the ends to hold the mask on to your head.
- Draw and cut out cars and a nose in coloured card.
- Colour the animal face using felt tipped pens.
- Stick the ears to the inside of the mask, and the nose on the front.
