






Desktop calendar

You will need ...

- A4 piece of card
- Hole punch
- String
- Paper
- Pens



- Ruler
- Glue or Pritt stick
- Scissors
- An old magazines.

What you do ...

- Hold an A4 sheet of card on its side (landscape) and mark a lint: 2 centimetres (1 inch) from one end.
- Divide the rest of the card in to three sections.
- Fold at the second line (the one nearest the end flap) and punch two holes.
- Fold in to a triangle shape and glue the small end flap to the base.
- Using plain white paper, make a page for each month, tying them on with string.
- On the left hand side of the paper, stick on pictures cut from magazines, to represent the months.
- On the right hand side, write in the month and the dates you might wish to prepare printed sheets of these pages off a computer to save time!
- Cub Scouts especially could use the picture space to right or draw a 'Promise' for what they would do that month.
