









Make a windmill

You will need...

- Paper
- Felt-tipped pens
- Pin
- Small bead
- Plastic drinking straw
- Piece of cork
- Scissors

What you do...

- Using the template on page 2, cut out the paper square, then cut it four times using the scissors along the dotted lines, but stop short of the centre each time
- Decorate both sides of the paper using the felt tipped pens
- Cut out the small circle from the template and push a pin through the middle of this circle
- Returning to the cut square of paper, bend every alternate corner-point into the centre and hold the points together, forming four cones. Then push the pin through all the layered points to secure them, covering them with the paper circle.
- Tum to the back of the windmill and push the pin through the eye of the of the small bead, then through the straw, near to the top of it. Once this has been done secure it by pushing the cork onto the pin (see the drawing above)
- Enjoy playing with youe windmill
